Who is eligible ?

- n Those that already exist !
- n Consider a take-over to accelerate applications - including the projects that they did – 5 year rule get approval before you buy in a letter from the ministry of agriculture
- n It is very important to make a planning 12 months upfront in cooperation with a team of specialists
- n Most investors are too late or do not want to pay for the expert team and they loose the money and effort

Easy and free money does not exist.....



Subsidy search & project engineering

- n Everything is in Romanian language because it is to early for translations
- n Hire a consultant/manager/interim manager with experience in the domain of structural instruments and/or structural funds
- n Start asap and make sure that the consultant/manager/interim manager does the job - We provide this services on an interim project management basis

POR guides – samples micro

- *Guide 2.1 Eligible applicants under this call for proposals are companies or cooperatives which fall into the category of micro-enterprises .*
- *The maximum amount of aid under the de minimis , which can be granted to a single undertaking is 200,000 euro*
- *The exchange rate RON / EUR used in this call for proposals is 4.43 RON / EUR*
- *works for construction / expansion / modernization of premises and production / supply of services micro businesses, including related general utilities (water supply, sewerage, gas, heating, electricity, PSI);*
- purchase of technological equipment, tools, work installations, furniture, computer equipment, office equipment, devices and measurement equipment, control and regulation;
- purchase of facilities / equipment specific to obtain energy savings, and systems using renewable / alternative energy to streamline activities for which it sought financing up to 15% of the eligible project
- Investment in intangible assets: patents, licenses, trademarks, software, other similar rights and assets
- Investment in the development of websites for presenting work and their products or services, including online marketing tools.

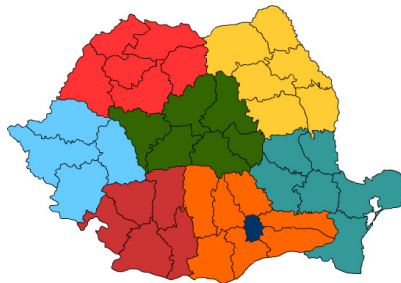

State aid 332/2014

Government Decision 332/2014 – State aid for investments which promote regional development through job creation

The state aid scheme is available to companies registered in Romania, for investments to be developed in Romania in any region

The state aid scheme aims promoting regional development through job creating

Overall budget: 600 million Euro

Annual budget: 100 million Euro

The total estimated number of companies which will benefit: 1700

Contracting period: July 1, 2014 – December 31, 2020

Payment period: 2015 – 2025

KEY CRITERIA FOR GRANTING THE STATE AID

The number of new jobs/minimum number of jobs to be created 10 Jobs

Period of creating at least 10 jobs – 1 YEAR

Location of investment - for counties where the unemployment rate is higher than the country's average

Net profit margin of the applicant in the last financial year above 2%

Share capital applicant (for the new established companies) above 35 000 LEI



State aid - 807/2014

Government decision 807/2014 – state aid for stimulating The investment with major impact in economy

DURATION AND BUDGET

The state aid is available for companies registered in Romania for investments to be developed in Romanian regions

The state aid aims to promote investments with major impact in economy

Overall budget: 600 million Euro

Annual budget: 100 million Euro

The total estimated number of companies to benefit of the scheme: 150

Contracting period: until December 31, 2020

Payment period: 2015 - 2023



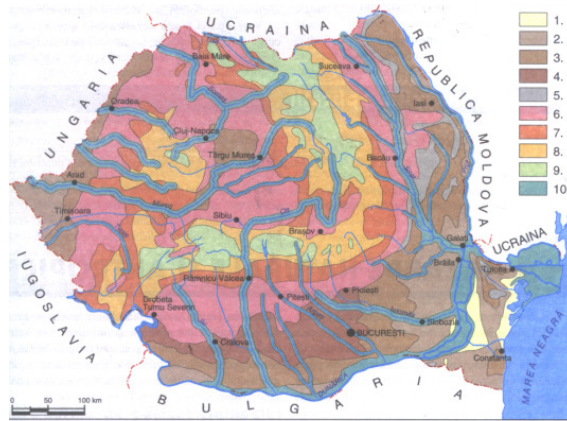

KEY CRITERIA FOR GRANTING THE STATE AID

Making an initial investment of at least 10 million euro, in sectors that are not specifically excluded from the scheme (non-eligible activities)

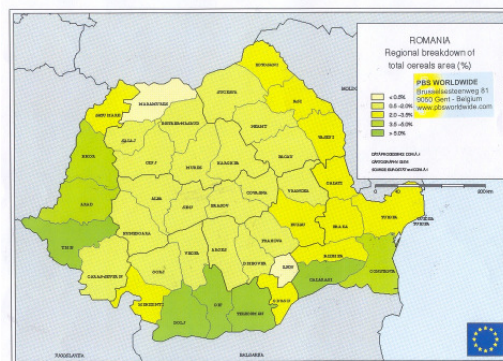
Maintaining the investment for a period of at least 5 years from the date of completion

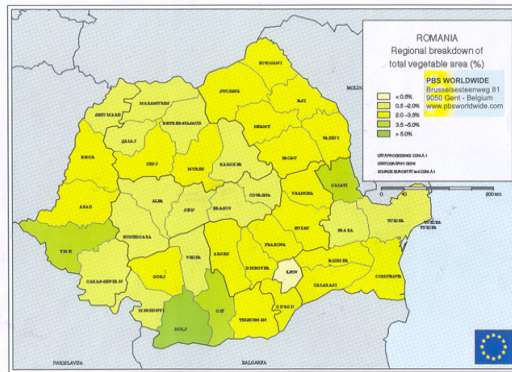
Cereals in Romania (source ins)

Vegetables in Romania

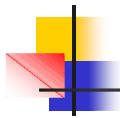
